APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Prior to Diane Figg giving the Treasurer's Report, Scott Sisteck reported that the last remaining check from Arona Borough has been received from Walter Geiger in the amount of \$21. Diane Figg reported that, not including the \$21 just received, the only bill outstanding is the legal bill in the amount of \$735 which will need to be approved. So before paying that and depositing the \$21 we have \$37,667.87 in the checking account. Ms. Figg also reported there was no activity other than interest earned since last meeting.

Paul Fry **MOVED** to approve the Treasurer's Report and pay the legal bill in the amount of \$735, and Ronald Martz **SECONDED**. No discussion. **Motion carried.**

AGENDA

- 1. Discussion with Berkheimer.** Susan Trout reported she has received emails regarding collections and some concerns with the process. Some folks are concerned that some businesses are remitting to the wrong collector or to a real estate appointed collector for the municipality. Shawn Perry responded that for the most part employers that continue to file at the wrong place, once they receive their quarterlies from Berkheimer in March, if they don't send them in by April 30th, they will begin to receive delinquents. Once they start getting delinquents they'll probably pay more attention to what they're doing. As far as the collectors working together, if they do accidentally send it to another collector, they will forward it onto us. Mr. Perry explained there is a verbal agreement between the tax collectors to get it to the right place. They'll also be notified so they can correct their books. Residency Verification forms went out to all employers and they

were instructed to have the employees complete the forms and keep them on file; this way they should know where the money is going to go and the code should already be in place. That should catch a great majority of them. If the smaller real estate collectors receive the payments, they can contact us and we will make sure we notify that employer who sent it incorrectly. The smaller businesses out there who didn't file in the past will get caught on the State list, which has moved up to a year instead of two years as it is now. They would have been notified, so we should essentially catch up with everybody. We're the only company that sent forms to both the employer and the taxpayer to make sure if we didn't reach the business the taxpayer would have the form to bring in to their employer so they would have it. That should be a big help as far as reaching all the employers. Peggy Gillespie was concerned that some businesses don't want to comply. Mr. Perry reiterated that once the quarterlies go out and they are delinquent they will be fined under Act 32 for being delinquent. And just because they sent it to someone else will not exclude them from that. As Mr. Perry mentioned before at a previous meeting the first and second quarter collections may be a bit low because of some of those employers. By the third quarter everything should be good to go. A question arose concerning when to expect distribution and Mr. Perry responded that payments aren't due until April 30th so you'll start seeing them come in April; full force in May. Another concern was brought up regarding receiving packets from Central Tax and Keystone informing those employers they should be sending the tax payments to their offices. Mr. Perry reminded everyone that if you have any employers who say they received a letter from a tax collector stating you have to file with them, tell them definitely not; you file with your County's collector and we'll send the money on from there.

2. **Selection of 2012 Operating Board.** Scott Sistek reported the requirement is to have five members representing the school districts and five members representing the cities, boroughs and townships. Additionally, you cannot have more than two members from within a school district's boundaries. Mr. Sistek commented that he would remain on the Board and addressed the current Board members about their desire to remain a member with the following responses: Peggy Gillespie, no, but will remain on the Transition Committee; Susan Trout, no; Diane Figg, yes; Caprice Mills, yes; Paul Fry, yes; James Meyer, no; John Wilson, no, per email sent to Ms. Trout; Jennifer Callahan, no, but will remain on Website Committee; and Greg Primm, yes. The following members were nominated and accepted their nominations: Eileen Navish; Diane Heming; Jude Abraham; Jon Perry; and Mike Wrobleski. Thomas Logan **MOVED** to close the nominations, and Jacob Blank **SECONDED**. No discussion. **Motion carried.**


Mr. Sistek thanked each member for volunteering to be a member of this Board.
